**Escot Education School Camp Kit List**

Sleeping Bag and roll mat (not air/camp beds) – wrapped in plastic bags

Wearing trousers, shirt, hoody/sweatshirt/jersey

Towel

2 Spare set of clothes in separate plastic bags – NOT smart clothing. Spare clothing to include an additional fleece (ideally) or jersey.

Hat (for warmth and against wet/sun)

Waterproof jacket plus waterproof trousers if they have them

Coat and gloves – evenings can be cold. If the waterproof jacket is warm it can be used as the coat as well.

Old trainers plus socks

Toothbrush/paste

Knife / fork / spoon / plate / mug – ideally plastic or enamel mug and plate

All contained in a bag or rucksack that will allow the child to carry their own belongings. Wheeled bags will not roll where we are going!

A spare bin bag for carrying away dirty items within their bags at the end of the camp.

Optional items:

Torch – ideally a head torch

Insect repellent

Suncream

Wellies

Flannel

Hairbrush or comb

All items to be named

We require information on any relevant health and diet issues. Special diet info required before the event to ensure suitable supplies are obtained.

All staff to have mobiles – no children to have mobiles.
