- Location: West Point, Exeter
- Price: £10 (Children are free on Sun. when accompanied by an adult)
- Date: Fri. 20th May
- Times: leave school 8am. Return to school for 5pm

Who can go?

- If you have been before, the show changes little from year to year. Leave it a couple of years & go again. If you have not been, it's a MUST
- Early GCSE & above. Yr10 & y11 will have exams & coursework on their minds. You don't have to go with school, you can of course go with your family at the weekend, Children are free on Sun. when accompanied by an adult.

Trip info

- You will need to bring money, £5 should be fine + I recommend packed lunch & drinks. They are expensive in the show.
 - There are loads of food opportunities, but they are expensive.
- The trip will be accompanied by Mr J & Keri Jenner
- Children will be encouraged to explore the show in small groups, these will be unsupervised.
- Each group will have a means of communicating with me, Mobile phones are ideal for this.
- Each pupil will be given a map of the show ground + a business card with contact information for myself, the school.
- We establishing a 'Meeting Point', at the entrance of the members area.

We take all the pupils there first, & then meet them there in the middle of the day & when we leave.

I was amazed when I did a show of hands in class, how many pupils have not attended the show & some had not even attended a village show either. It is such a big part of West County & English life, I'd strongly recommend pupils attend, there is so much to see & do, a wonderful day out.
