Pocket money

- The holiday is Full Board, so no money needed for lunch, unless they want a soft drink.
- Coke or coffee will cost about £2.50 £3.00
- Either UK sterling or Euro's, I can change money at the resort.
- I encourage parents/pupils to give their money to me for safe keeping & to divide it up into equal daily allowances.

 I had one 16yr old boy who insisted he was mature enough to look after his own money & then spent over £100 on the games machines at Gatwick before we took off for our holiday & arrived broke!
- I will confiscate money off any pupils who infringe our rules regarding what they can & can not purchase.
- As a guide €10 a day pocket money seems reasonable, + any money for presents/souvenirs. Some money to purchase a snack, drink & magazine at the airport at each end is a good idea.

Alcohol & Cigarettes

As school, the drinking of any alcoholic drink or smoking of tobacco is forbidden. Unlike the UK these can be easily purchased by the pupils.

- We have always found it necessary to be very strict with the pupils.
- The problem can lie with older pupils, so these measures will be more strictly monitored/directed towards them.
- To monitor this we will search pupils rooms, at regular intervals during the week.
- Pupils will not be allowed out to shop unsupervised, particularly to the local supermarket. Again the older you are, the more strict we will be.
- Until pupils are settled in their rooms & largely asleep, we will hold their room keys, to help us monitor them.
 Last thing at night we will hand the keys back to the pupils, so they can lock their doors.

 - § max size: 56cm x 45cm x 25cm including wheels, handles etc Cabin luggage size is strictly enforced.
 - § This one bag includes, handbags, cameras etc, so only 1 bag
 - **§** put liquids, like shampoo, tooth paste in your hold luggage, not your hand luggage.
 - **§** A laptop bag will be regarded as your one item that is allowed in the cabin.
 - Don't take a laptop or iPod or Phone, they are all to easily broken, damaged, lost or stolen.
 - **§** Pack all sharp objects in your hold luggage.
 - **§** Pack a pair of ski socks in your hand luggage, as ski fitting is on arrival at the resort.
 - § Medication, carry additional supplies in your hand luggage, in case your hold luggage is lost.
