(Entry by hips, vertical paddle shaft, close to boat, exit by toes,	Worth
Sweep Stoke (a turning stoke, spins boat on spot)	Stephany
(Entry by toes, wide-sweeping stroke, paddle shaft horizontal to water, exit by stern)	Pockock
Reverse Sweep Stroke	Rebekah
(Entry by stern, sweep out & back to bow)	Worth
Combined Front & Reverse Sweep Strokes	Chantelle Bibby
Stern Rudder	Alice
(Paddle at 30° to water, rear blade submerged in water, shaft parallel to boat)	Jenner
Bow Rudder	Lewis
(Paddle between knee & seat, vertical paddle shaft, blade parallel to boat)	Chambers
Advanced Bow Rudder	Tom
(as above, varying position of blade to accomplish 180° turn)	Allbrook
T-Draw	Stephany
(Paddle shaft near vertical, wrist against forehead, slice blade out, pull in)	Pockock
Sculling Draw (Figure of 8 action providing continuous force)	Alistair

Low Support	Ben
(Boat goes off balance, back of blade presented to water, elbows over paddle shaft, hip flick back upright)	Carter
High Support	Tom
(Boat off balance, face of blade presented to water, elbows under paddle shaft, hip flick back upright)	Allbrook
Wet Exit	Lucy
(Roll boat upside down, 3 bangs on boat, remove spay deck, roll out of boat, regain hold of paddle & boat)	Jenner
Rocking-boat	Jonathan
(Dynamically roll boat side to side with hips, so each cockpit rim gets wet)	Sailsbury
Practise hip flick	Lewis
(Hold onto front of partners boat, roll boat upside down, hip flick boat upright)	Chambers
Eskimo rescue	Lewis
(Roll boat upside down, bang boat 3 times, brush hands up & down side of boat, until rescue boats bow	Symonds
presented, roll back up using their bow)	
Eskimo roll (right handed)	James
(Setup blade parallel to boat, push hand to surface, rotate blade to 30°, sweep out to 90°, pull down on blade & dynamically hip flick boat up, keeping head in water)	Ward
Eskimo roll (left handed)	Ben
(as above but on off side)	Carter
Hand roll	Tom
(as above but without paddle)	Albrook
Storm Roll	Ben
(As Eskimo roll, but paddle deep in water, approach vertical)	Carter
Double Pump	Ben
(The building block for free style moves)	Carter
Stern Squirt	Tom
(Sweep stroke, edge boat, aggressive reverse sweep with stern lean, slice paddle forward & pull to bow)	Albrook
Relay race	All Kayakers
