Dry-Ski Slope Courses & Snow Dome Trip

The last thing you want is to arrive at your expensive ski resort, to find you spend the first couple of days on the nursery slopes, when your $\pounds 150$ ski pass gives you access to the whole mountain.

The course is open to any pupils who are be interested, whether-or-not they intend to join the school ski holiday.

You need to be aware though, that falling over on the dry-ski-slope can be very painful & broken limbs can happen, although often through disregarding instructions. Also Skiing is inherently risky. You should only undertake this activity if you & your guardians are personally prepared to accept these risks & recognise that you will be exposed to potentially life-threatening situations.

Clothing for the lessons:

Old trousers, long sleeved jumper/jacket, thick clothes help cushion the falls & **Gloves**. Food & Drink

Please ensure pupils bring a snack, skiing is very physically demanding & after a long day at school, they get very hungry. There is a hot drinks machine £0.30 per drink, takes 10p & 20p pieces only. Flap jacks, biscuits, sandwiches, fruit are all good examples, it is best to give them too much.

Code of Conduct For Skiing

- **§** Follow instructions closely.
- **§** Don't go higher than you're told on the slopes.
- **§** Do have fun.
- **§** Do take care.
- **§** Do wear gloves.
- **§** Do remember some change for a hot drink/snack after.
- § Don't ski too fast
- **§** Don't ski out of control.
- **§** Remember you are legally responsible for accidents if you ski into someone below you.
- **§** Don't jump the line for the lifts.
- § Don't start skiing until the instructor or Mr J says so.
- **§** Listen closely to the instructors.
- **§** Don't talk when the instructor is.
- **§** If mum/dad is picking you up from the slopes, remember to take all your school bags, lunch boxes etc, down on the bus.
- **§** Get changed into your ski at the end of school.
- **§** Be polite to everyone.

It's a good idea to bring a hat & rain coat (the slope is much more fun when its wet).
